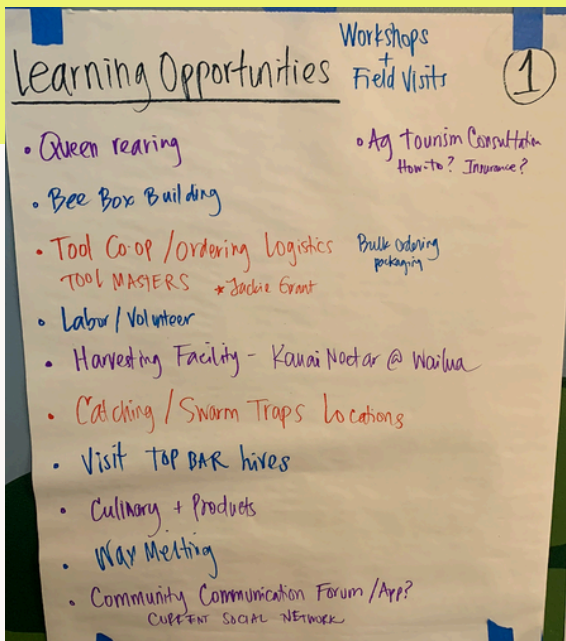

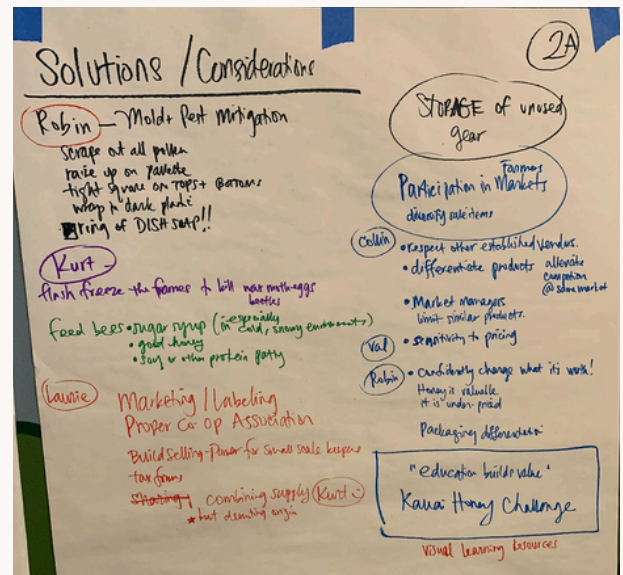
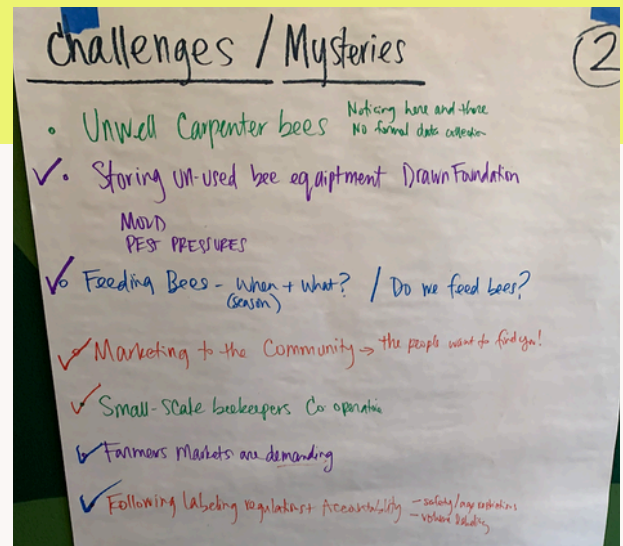

## HOW TO STORE DRAWN FRAMES

Flash freeze frames. Dig out all pollen. place in boxes with tight fitting tops & bottoms. Wrap entire boxes in dark plastic, raise them off the ground & use a ring of dish soap/ other pest deterrent around the bundles.

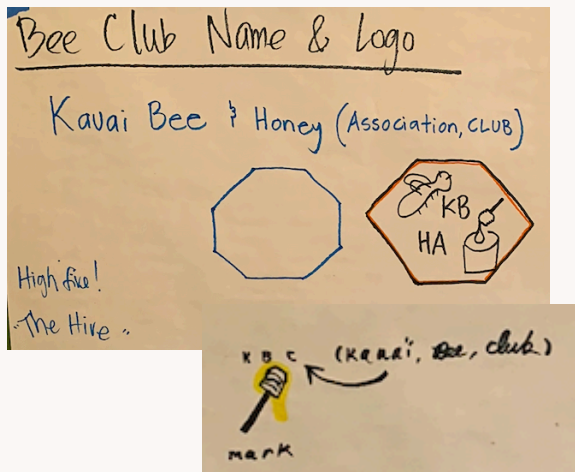

CRB TREATMENTS & HONEYBEES

\*All insecticides are harmful for pollinators and beneficial insects  
-Severity depends upon their class, mode of action and dose.

Lethal effects: direct & indirect contact. Sub-lethal effects: low dose exposure effects navigation, foraging, reproduction, development, immunity & behavior. TRIM THOSE PALM BLOSSOMS OF ANY TREATED TREE.
